

Dear Republican State Committee Members,

For years, we the undersigned were strong supporters of the Massachusetts Republican Party and, collectively gave more than \$900,000 to support the party's mission. We were proud of the Party's success and the candidates that it helped to elect across the Commonwealth.

When we make political donations, our expectations are twofold. First, we expect that party funds will be used to increase the MassGOP's appeal, and grow the base of voters that are willing to register as or vote for Republicans. Second, we expect that the MassGOP will support candidates for public office, and that those candidates will be more successful at the ballot box because of our contributions.

Unfortunately, since 2019 the Party has seemingly strayed from the principles and values that brought us success. We were disappointed that the party provided lackluster financial support for candidates in the 2020 elections, and abandoned the MassVictory field and data program, leading to the loss of five legislative seats.

Over the past six weeks, we have lost our remaining confidence in current party leadership. The State Chair failed to denounce homophobia, used party resources to openly attack 29 of the elected Republican house members, is under investigation by law enforcement for potential campaign finance violations, and is facing calls for resignation from elected officials, past party Chairmen, and from major media outlets like the Boston Herald. Due to these events, we are no longer comfortable providing financial support to the MassGOP.

Many of our fellow Republican donors have already demonstrated their dissatisfaction with the current status of the MassGOP: The party is quickly slipping towards insolvency, and does not have the funds to participate in special elections, fund a state convention, or support a slate of legislative, congressional, and statewide candidates in 2022.

We are, however, eager to support a positive, big-tent MassGOP that demonstrates the ability to effectively compete in Massachusetts' elections. If the state committee takes appropriate action to restore the Massachusetts Republican Party's reputation, and further acts to reorient party leadership towards the business of electing more Republicans, we the undersigned will commit to giving and/or raising \$1 million so that the MassGOP has the funds to succeed in 2022.
